Course Overview: Integrated Math I is the first in a series of three integrated math courses. This course emphasizes linear and exponential expressions, equations, and functions. This course also focuses on geometric congruence and interpreting linear models from quantitative data. Students continue their learning and understanding of categorical and quantitative data. Students are introduced to reasoning with equations by solving systems of equations in two variables. Students will take the TNReady assessment which counts 25% of the second semester grade. The following topics will be covered in this course;

- 1) Quantities and Relationships
- 2) Sequence
- 3) Linear Functions
- 4) Modeling Linear Relationships
- 5) Linear Equations and Inequalities, 6) Systems of Equations and Inequalities, 7) Exponential Functions,
- 8) Geometry, 9) Statistics
